Das, the learned counsel appears for the respondent Nos.2 and 3-the office of the Principal Accountant General (A & E) and Mr. R. Borpujari, the learned counsel appears for the Treasury Officer, Jonai-respondent No.4.

Mr. S. Das, the learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Higher Education Department, Mr. J. Das, the learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No. 2 & 3 and Mr. R. As regards the respondent No. 6, steps be taken by way of registered post with A/D as well as usual process within three days.

The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner retired on 30/6/2022. Thereupon his pension papers were sent to the office of the Accountant General(A & E), Assam. The Senior Account Officer of the office of the Principal Accountant General (A &E) had pointed out a deficiency as regards over drawal of Rs. 4,55,100/- on account of wrong fixation of salary and the said amount has been deducted from the DCRG payable to the petitioner.

Being aggrieved, the petitioner is before this Court by way of the instant writ petition.

The counsels appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 5 shall apprise this Court on the returnable date as to whether the petitioner had any role in the wrong fixation of his salary which led to over drawal amount of Rs.4,55,100/- and further as to whether the principles laid down in the case of **State of Punjab Vs. Rafiq Masih(White Washer) and Ors.** reported in (2015) 4 SCC 334 shall not apply.

Liberty is given to the petitioner to mention the matter for upgrading.

Such deduction/recovery on account on overpayments made to the petitioner during his service because of mistake in fixation of his pay. Accordingly, recovery of the said amount was made from the petitioner's retirement benefits.

MOST RESPECTFULLY BEGS TO STATE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the petitioner is a citizen of India and a resident of the above-mentioned locality and he is thereby entitled to all the rights and privileges guaranteed to a citizen of India by the Constitution of India and the laws framed thereunder.

2. That the petitioner retired from Murkong Selek College on 30.6.2020² and at the time of his retirement, he held the post of Library Bearer in the said college.
3. That the petitioner had initially joined service as a Library Bearer at Murkong Selek College in Jonai on 19.9.1985. The petitioner's appointment in the said post was approved by an order dated 26.2.1993 (Memo No. G(A)CAN.9/93/41) issued by the Joint Director of Higher Education, Assam. The petitioner's appointment as a Library Bearer was approved with effect from 1.4.1992.

A copy of the petitioner's joining report dated 19.9.1985 is attached herewith as Annexure 1.

A copy of the order dated 26.2.1993 (Memo No. G(A)CAN.9/93/41) issued by the Joint Director of Higher Education, Assam is attached herewith as Annexure 2.

4. That, the petitioner's service as Library Bearer at Murkong Selek College was also confirmed with effect from 9.12.1996 by an order dated 2.1.1997 (Memo No.

G(A)AC/N/9/93/pt/20) issued by the Inspector of Colleges, Assam.

A copy of the order dated 22.12.2003 (Memo No. G(B) AC/Conf/22/02/189) issued by the Inspector of Colleges, Assam, is attached herewith as Annexure 3.

5. That, on 26.11.2021, by an Order issued by the Director of Higher Education, Assam (Memo No. DHE/ACA/MACPS/06/2019/Pt./107-131), the petitioner was granted 3% increment as financial upgradation benefit (2nd MACPS) under the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) of the Government of Assam.

A copy of Order dated 26.11.2021 (Memo No. DHE/ACA/MACPS/06/2019/Pt./107-131) issued by the Director of Higher Education, Assam, is attached herewith as Annexure 4.

6. That, upon the retirement of the petitioner on 30.6.2022, the Principal of Murkong Selek College issued a Non-Liabilities Certificate wherein it is stated that the petitioner has no

financial liabilities during his service period in the college and is thereby free from any liabilities in the college.

A copy of the Non-Liabilities certificate issued by the Principal of Murkong Selek College is attached herewith as Annexure 5.

7. That, after the retirement of the petitioner, the Senior Accounts Officer at the Office of the Accountant General (A&E), Assam, wrote a letter to the Principal of Murkong Selek College on 4.8.2022 stating that upon scrutiny of the petitioner's service book, it was found that his scale of pay from 1.1.1996 had been fixed at a higher rate that it ought to have been. The Principal of Murkong Selek College was accordingly requested to re-examine and resubmit the petitioner's case again after necessary correction of pay from the date of joining to the date of retirement. As regards waiver of recovery, the Principal was requested to consult Finance Department's Memo No. (BC-III) 1808/2018/2 dated 14.6.2019. It was stated that if the pension papers are submitted without enclosing the waiving order then The Accountant General's office would consider that the department agreed towards recovery and accordingly his office would settle the pension case.

It would be pertinent to mention herein that there was a typographical error and the Finance Department's Memo No. ought to have written as "(EC-III) 1808/2018/2" instead of "(BC-III) 1808/2018/2".

A copy of the Letter No. Pen-2/EDNT-11/094362/2022/1227 dated 4.8.2022 issued by the Senior Accounts Officer at the Office of the Accountant General (A&E), Assam, to the Principal of Murkong Selek College is attached herewith as Annexure 6.

8. That despite the issue of Non-Liabilities Certificate to the petitioner, an amount of Rs. 4,55,100/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty-Five Thousand One Hundred only) has been recovered from the petitioner on account of overdrawal of salary.

A copy of Recovery Statement in respect of the petitioner is attached herewith as Annexure 7.

9. That, the overdrawal by the petitioner of Rs. 4,55,100/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty-Five Thousand One Hundred only) has been recovered by deducting the said amount from the petitioner's Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity. In this regard,

instructions had been issued by the Senior Accounts Officer at the Office of the Accountant General (A&E), Assam, to the Treasury Officer, Jonai, vide Letter No. PR-2/EDN/11/094362/2022 dated 13.10.2022.

A copy of the Letter No. PR-2/EDN/11/094362/2022 dated 13.10.2022 issued by the Senior Accounts Officer, O/o the Principal Accountant General (A&E) Assam, to the Treasury Officer, Jonai, is attached herewith as Annexure 8.

10. That, the petitioner sincerely begs to state that the mistake during fixation of the petitioner's pay, if any, was committed by officials of the respondent authorities and not by the petitioner. Such mistake was not corrected throughout the tenure of his service. By elapse of significant time, the petitioner was under no doubt even that the amount of his pay had been correctly ascertained. Accordingly, he had a legitimate expectation with respect to the amount of pensionary benefits including death-cum-retirement gratuity that he would receive and had prepared retirement plans accordingly. After his retirement, it is completely unjustified to penalize him by deducting from his

Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity the amount of overpayment made to him in respect of pay and allowances.

Also, it would be pertinent to mention herein that the petitioner worked in a position which is a not a very high-ranking and high-paying one. He had a very modest income from which he could only save very modestly for his retirement. Thereby, deducting overpayments made to him at this stage is absolutely unjust and inhuman and is causing severe financial difficulty to the petitioner and his family. Such action completely destabilizes his plans at a critical stage when he would not be able to undertake any other work to earn an income. Penalty for such overpayment, if any, must be imposed on the person who committed the mistake in fixing the petitioner's pay and allowances.

11. That, the law is settled with respect to impermissibility of recovering excess salary paid to employees who have retired. The petitioner begs to rely upon the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *State of Punjab & Ors. Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer) & Ors.* reported in (2015) 4 SCC 334. In Para 18 of the said judgement, the Hon'ble Supreme Court had laid down as follows:

"18. It is not possible to postulate all situations of hardship which would govern employees on the issue of recovery, where

payments have mistakenly been made by the employer, in excess of their entitlement. Be that as it may, based on the decisions referred to herein above, we may, as a ready reference, summarise the following few situations, wherein recoveries by the employers, would be impermissible in law:

- (i) recovery from employees belonging to Class-III and Class-IV service (or Group 'C' and Group 'D' service),*
- (ii) recovery from retired employees, or employees who are due to retire within one year, of the order of recovery.*
- (iii) recovery from employees, when the excess payment has been made for a period in excess of five years, before the order of recovery is issued.*
- (iv) recovery in cases where an employee has wrongfully been required to discharge duties of a higher post, and has been paid accordingly, even though he should have rightfully been required to work against an inferior post.*
- (v) In any other case, where the Court arrives at the conclusion, that recovery if made from the employee, would be iniquitous or harsh or arbitrary to such an extent, as would far outweigh the equitable balance of the employer's right to recover."*

12. That, subsequent to the aforesaid order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *State of Punjab & Ors. Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer) & Ors.*, the Finance Department of the Government of Assam had issued Office Memorandum No. Fin(EC-III) 1808/2018/2 dated 14.6.2019 instructing all departments to act in accordance with the stipulations

prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court while deciding cases of wrongful/excess payments. Although there is a clear reference to this Office Memorandum in the Letter No. Pen-2/EDNT-11/094362/2022/1227 dated 4.8.2022 issued by the Senior Accounts Officer at the Office of the Accountant General (A&E), Assam, to the Principal of Murkong Selek College, but it was never brought to the notice of the petitioner nor was he informed about its contents and provisions.

A copy of Office Memorandum No. Fin(EC-III) 1808/2018/2 dated 14.6.2019 issued by the Finance Department of the Government of Assam is attached herewith as Annexure 9.

13. That it is therefore absolutely iniquitous to recover the overpayment made to the petitioner from his Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity. The Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity is an amount that is independently payable to the petitioner and deduction of any overpayments from it is impermissible in law.

14. That the recovery after the petitioner's retirement of overpayments made to him during his service is completely

unreasonable and arbitrary and thereby in violation of the petitioner's fundamental rights guaranteed under Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

- 15.** That the impugned orders are also malicious in law and on facts. The manner in which the impugned orders were issued reflects malafide intentions of the decision-maker.
- 16.** That no reasonable person appropriately instructed in law could have taken a decision of the nature that has been impugned in the present case.
- 17.** That, in the premises aforesaid, it is most humbly stated that this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to interfere in exercise of its extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and to direct the Respondents No. 2, 3 & 4 to return to the petitioner the amount of Rs. 4,55,100/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty-Five Thousand One Hundred only) which was deducted from his Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity.
- 18.** That there is no other remedy available to the petitioner and the remedy sought for is just, adequate and complete.

19. That the cause of action for filing this petition arises within the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court and the same still counts.
20. That this petition is made bonafide and for the ends of justice.

PRAYERS

In the premises aforesaid, it is most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to admit this petition, call for the records and issue rule upon the respondents directing them to show-cause as to why:

- (i) A writ in the nature certiorari should not be issued setting aside and quashing the Letter No. PR-2/EDN/11/094362/2022 dated 13.10.2022 issued by the Senior Accounts Officer, O/o the Principal Accountant General (A&E) Assam, to the Treasury Officer, Jonai, to the extent it contained a direction to recover/deduct an amount of Rs. 4,55,100/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty-Five Thousand One Hundred only) from

the Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity of the petitioner;

- (ii) An direction should not be issued to the Respondents No. 2, 3 and 4 to pay to the petitioner the amount of Rs. 4,55,100/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty-Five Thousand One Hundred only) which was deducted from his Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity; and/or
- (iii) any other writ(s)/order(s)/direction(s) should not be issued as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper.

AND FOR SUCH ACT OF KINDNESS, THE PETITIONER AS IN DUTY-BOUND SHALL EVER PRAY.




